been exposed should follow strict quarantine rules in the adoptive home for a minimum of 2 months
post adoption as recommended by IMPS. It is also strongly recommended the adopter seek professional
advice from the vet that will be caring for the adoptive dog for any additional recommendations on its
care.
The list of vaccinations below is also required as part of the adoption contract unless indicated that they
have been administered by the rescue:
Dhpp given at week 7
Dhpp given at week 10
Dhpp given at week 12-13 (per vets preference)
Rabies given at week 16 (some vets may <u>recommend</u> an additional Dhpp booster as well)
Thank you for understanding that the parvovirus is a highly transferable, difficult to kill virus that is
potentially fatal to dog with compromised immune systems or under developed immune systems, such
as, seniors and puppies. Please protect your dog's life with core vaccinations!
